The laser beam will target the fungus across the nail bed. As nails grow slowly, results become visible several months later.

You will feel a small amount of heat generated by the laser for a few minutes. No anesthesia is required. You can wear socks and shoes immediately after the procedure.

To minimise the risk of recurrence, you may need additional treatments depending on the severity of the infection.
